Phonemic Awareness

- *Rhyming
 - Pause and let fill in/say missing rhyming word
- *Alliteration
 - Beginning Sound Hunt -- Look for objects in the house that begin with a certain sound.
- *Syllable Splitting and Counting
 - Say the name of places where Bo Peep's sheep might have hid (barn, stable, house, henhouse, near water, etc.) Have your child pat a toy lamb for each syllable heard and tell you the total number of syllables for each place named.
- *Blending Onsets and Rimes
 - Show three pictures. Say the name of one of the pictures, broken into an onset and rime. Have your child find and point to the picture that you named.
