Phonemic Awareness

- *Auditory Discrimination
 - Listening Walk.-- take a walk downtown and listen for sounds in the city
 - Listening for words that are the same and different
- *Rhyming
 - Pause and let fill in/say missing rhyming word
- *Segmenting Sentences
 - Press a button on a play phone as each word in the nursery rhyme is spoken
